- What was my best experience?
- What did I learn about myself?
- What did I learn about my coach/teacher?
- What did I learn about my team mates or class mates?
- Why was it such a good experience?
- What would I like to see more of?

Your answers can be completed through a 1 minute video, multimedia presentation, or poem (300 words maximum), art work (with a short 100 word explanation) and song, rap or using any method that you feel will have a positive impact in sharing your views on the question. The limits stated above must be adhered to, in order to be considered for prizes.

Who is eligible?

Children and youth in Ireland. You can enter as an individual or as part of a group project or both.

Reward offered:

There will be prizes of Tablet PC's for the 2 overall winners. Mystery prizes will be presented for excellence in creativity and innovation. In addition, certificates of accomplishment will also be issued to commended entrants.

6. The competition runs from 30th December 2015 to 16th March 2016. Late entries will not be considered.
7. Entries produced in either the English or Irish language will be accepted.
8. All entries will be reviewed independently and equally.
9. Entries considered offensive will not be considered.
10. Parental consent has been received for all participants. Your school's Parental Consent forms do not need to be sent to us, but you must acknowledge that they have been completed and received to complete the application process.
11. Winners will be announced during the week beginning 1st May 2016.
12. Prizewinners will be selected by a panel of special guest judges. The judges' decision is final in all matters.
13. UNESCO IT Tralee may request more information from entrants should your video be shortlisted or to clarify information relating to an entry.
14. Prizewinners agree to participate in such reasonable publicity as may be requested by UNESCO IT Tralee and/or partners.
15. Prizewinners will be invited to the PEPAYS Conference, to receive their prizes and view their entries on display.

- Videos can be submitted in English or Irish. If your video is in Irish, you may wish to consider including English subtitles to appeal to a wider audience. However, this is not obligatory and all videos will be considered equally.
